1. Any child 5 years of age and under is eligible to participate.
2. Children can pre-register by completing the attached form.
 - Return email to whitcombct@comcast.net
 - Print and bring to event by 5:00 PM.
3. Babies can parade in decorated carriages, wagons, strollers, etc.
 - Not larger than 42"x 25"x 40" high.
 - NO MOTOR-PROPELLED VEHICLES.
 - All must be hand pulled or pushed.
4. Only one person may accompany the entrant (two if someone is needed to pull the entrant).
5. No live animals permitted.
6. No sparkers or fireworks allowed.
7. Judging will be based on divisional themes and originality.
8. Judges will confer to reach a majority decision, AND THEIR DECISION WILL BE FINAL.

Children are registered free with an adult.

All registrants will receive a bib with a participant number.

Bibs must be visible at all times during judging and the parade.

Children participating in the event must be supervised at all times.

The committee reserves the right to reject any entry not meeting their approval.
